CRISIS LINE

If you or someone you know is experiencing a mental health, substance use or emotional concern, this service is for you.

The Crisis Line consists of a hotline (professional crisis counselors), a warm line (peer specialists who have gone through similar experiences), text and chat. Our trained staff can help you manage the situation, provide immediate support and solutions, and connect you to further resources if needed.

They may also send a mental health professional to provide support for individuals who are in need of face-to-face help.

CRISIS WALK-IN CENTERS / STABILIZATION UNITS

Our walk-in centers are open 24/7, and offer confidential, in-person support, information and referrals to anyone in need.

If you need assistance when helping others with a crisis, you can always go to a walk-in center near you. Some locations provide crisis beds for stays of 1-5 days for either voluntary or involuntary treatment.
